



Camp Director Notes at Vanguard

Welcome to U.S. Spiritleaders Camp at Vanguard University Drop Off and Check In Procedures:

Please do not check in prior to 12:00pm. Vanguard is a very small campus. Check In will be in front of the School Gym which is in the center of the campus. Please have one coach/advisor check in with the Spiritleaders staff. All students, parents, should wait by their cars or bus to find out if it would be closer to drive to another parking lot to get to your dorms.

There will be a brief meeting Thursday at approximately 2:45 pm prior to the start of camp. Please meet by the main stage on the field. This meeting is for advisors and coaches. Rey will be going over some important information so please plan to attend. All of the Co-Camp Directors and Support Staff will be there to meet you.

If you have any questions pertaining to camp, instructors, material, let one of the Camp Directors know and they will talk with the head instructors about your questions. Commonly Asked Questions:

Bedding:

Please bring all bedding including pillows and towels.

I am locked out of my room, what do I do?

If it is between 7:00 am and 11:00 pm you may call Leesa and she or one of her assistants will be happy to come and open the room for you. We suggest that the coach or advisor collect one key per room so you have a spare in case of lockouts. You will be told at check in what to do if the lockout occurs between **11:00 pm and 7:00 am.**

What do I do with my keys upon check out Sunday?

Please organize your key cards by floor order number from smallest to greatest just like you received them. Please return them to Leesa in the same box you received them. You will be told at one of our advisor meetings where to meet Leesa to turn in your keys. The staff will be there from 12-4 to assist any coaches wanting to check out early prior to Spirit Spectacular.

Is there an EMT on site?

Yes, we have an EMT down on the field daily for any injuries. There will also be an EMT in the dorms. Call Leesa after camp hours if you need an EMT. If you send for the EMT, please have someone wait in the lobby of your dorm to let them in and direct them to the person who needs help. Remember, the EMT is here for injuries and emergencies. They will not tape wrists or ankles just to give support. You must do that as a coach or an advisor.
